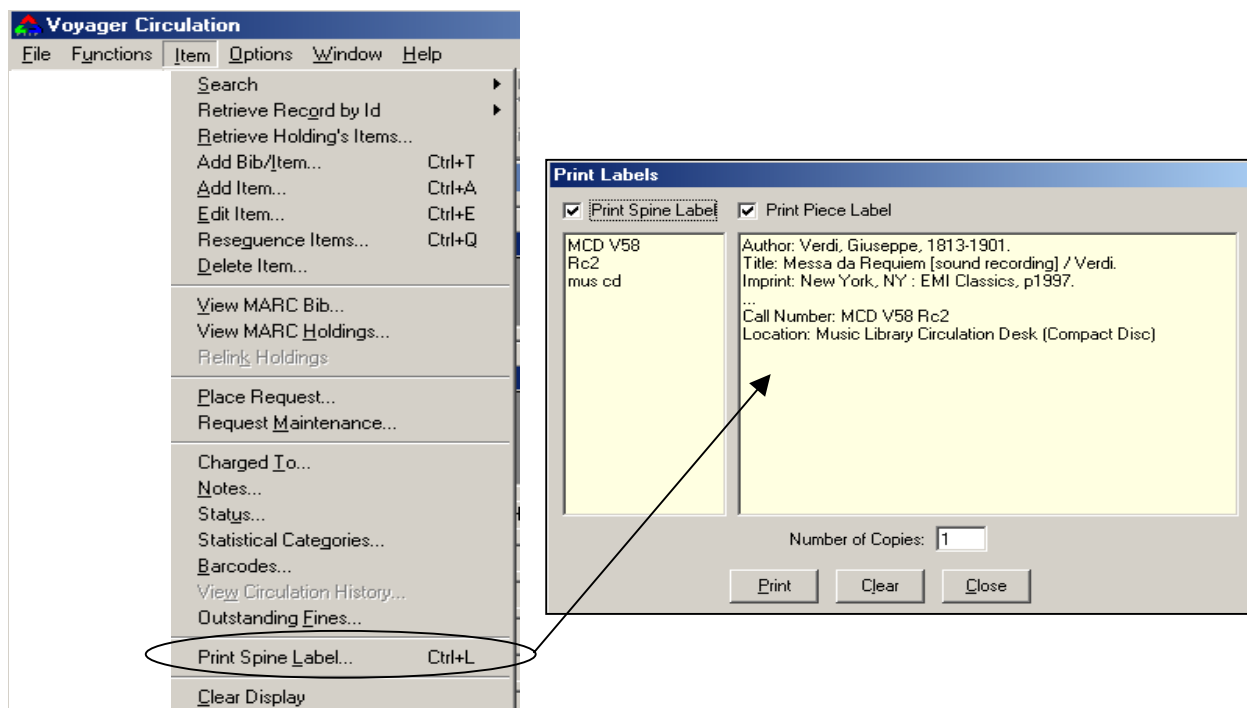


Print Spine Labels (Circulation Module)

The Print Labels feature (under the Item Menu, or **Ctrl-L**) allows you to quickly copy or print an item's basic cite and call number. The default label doesn't contain much, but you can (crudely) configure selected fields. Here is a sample label:



To set this up:

- Open the Spinelabel.cfg file in C:\Voyager\Misc. (local drives may vary).
- Find the stanza called [Print Template Piece Item]. Replace it with the coding below. Save.
